

NEW MEMBER CHECKLIST

(Steps necessary to advance from **RED** Badge to the **BLUE** Badge)

<u>DATE</u>	
	Be a greeter, introducing yourself to member Rotarians, and taking special note of visiting Rotarians. You will be introducing the visiting Rotarians to the club.
	Participate in a club activity outside of the regular weekly meeting (such as a service project, club social event, Board of Directors meeting, fundraiser, etc.)
	Review and/or Register your personal records in District 5100 dacDB and RI_Rotary Central (your sponsor or mentor can help with this).
	Visit (make-up) at another Rotary club. Local meeting times and places are listed on the District 5100 web site (https://www.isrotaryforyou.com/). We recommend that you attend with your sponsor or another Rotarian from our club.
	Bring a guest (prospective member) to a club meeting.
	Attend a Fireside Meeting. These are scheduled every couple of months. A Fireside is usually a dinner meeting held in the home of a Rotarian from our club. It is an opportunity for your and your spouse (or significant other) to learn more about Rotary.
	Give a classification talk. This is a brief biography of you and a little about your profession. See the Classification outline if you need some guidelines.

NOTE TO NEW MEMBERS: This indoctrination to the Lewis River Rotary Club should take approximately eight weeks. Your sponsor is responsible to help you through the above steps to help introduce you to Rotary. Please feel free to call on any of the officers or directors if you have questions.
